Time4Sustainable Development (T4SD) explores how the 17 Sustainable Development Goals can serve as a reference framework to support organisations to contribute to the Goals, improve their CSR engagement with societal organisations and, at the same time, ensure the engagement and development of their employees.

The T4SD project objectives are to:


- develop an innovative approach that supports CSR initiatives which contribute to the SDGs through societal projects and within organisational work practices.
- develop, test and validate a CPD programme for Educators, HR Managers and Trainers to enable them to

Participants will learn how to facilitate:

Quality Assurance or Evaluation Strategy

Competence assessment instruments, such as focus group and digital self-reflection questionnaires will be applied in order to make participants aware of their learning developments.

As an option, the participants can also apply the LEVEL5 competence validation tools in order to self assess competence development in the facilitation of SDG integration into organisations.

The T4SD CPD training programme is designed to build an individuals facilitation competences within the context of embedding the SDGs within working practices. Through an experiential learning approach learners will experience Design Thinking, problem solving and collaborative learning in highly participative workshops. It is offered as a modular, blended learning CPD programme.

Facilitation Processes

A sustainability management system that enables

The Time4Sustainable Development CPD programme will enable facilitators to apply the 'Plan, Do, Check, Act' PDCA methodology for quality managemer facilitation processes it promotes.




Further Information
